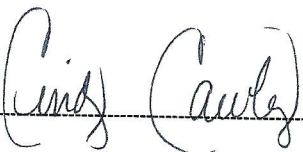

Oak Bank had provided documentation showing county funds are properly collateralized and held in safekeeping.

Judge Bradley later told commissioners the county's proposed budget was being completed and would be filed Monday. The filing begins the timetable for budget hearings and consideration of salaries for elected officials.

Bradley said the county's certified taxable value is down a little more than \$17 million from the previous year. He said the decline could result in significant cuts in the proposed budget as commissioners attempt to balance county needs without increasing the tax rate.

Bradley added that the county's no-new-revenue tax rate is approximately 71 cents, although the final rate
