NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within the Plateau Underground Water Conservation & Supply District, consisting of Schleicher County: That the Board of Directors of the Plateau Underground Water Conservation & Supply District ("District") will hold a hearing on the application(s) for a Water Well Permit by the below listed parties on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, beginning at 12:30 PM at the Schleicher County Annex, 203 SW Main, Eldorado, Texas.


NOTICE is hereby specifically given to:

1. Bert Bruton, for one proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 55 minutes, 33.50 seconds North and longitude of 100 degrees, 48 minutes, 20.42 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 250 acre-feet production of groundwater annually; irrigation.
2. Bailey Land & Pecan Co c/o John Clinton & LeeAnn Bailey, pecan orchard, change of ownership.
3. Archie Crenwelge, for a proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 59 minutes, 46.59 seconds North and a longitude of 100 degrees, 31 minutes, 02.52 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 60 acre feet production of groundwater annually; irrigation.
4. Archie Crenwelge, for a proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 00 minutes, 14.99 seconds North and a longitude of 100 degrees, 31 minutes, 21.10 seconds; not to exceed 60 acre feet production of groundwater annually; irrigation
5. Russell Crenwelge, for a proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 49 minutes, 07.73 seconds North and longitude of 100 degrees, 45 minutes, 23.57 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 100 ac ft; irrigation
6. Russell Crenwelge, for a proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 49 minutes, 22.79 seconds North and a longitude of 100 degrees, 45 minutes, 53.22 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 100 ac ft; irrigation
7. Russell Crenwelge, for a proposed Water Well Permit; existing well is located at a latitude of 30 degrees, 49 minutes, 18.46 seconds North and longitude of 100 degrees, 45 minutes, 53.38 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 250 ac ft production of groundwater annually; irrigation.
8. Len P. Mertz, for a proposed Water Well Permit; well to be drilled at a latitude of 30 degrees, 48 minutes, 18.5 seconds North and longitude of 100 degrees, 36 minutes, 53.4 seconds West in Schleicher County; not to exceed 250 acre feet production of groundwater annually; industry

If approved, the permits requested in the applications above would authorize the permit holder to withdraw groundwater from a water well according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. If you would like to contest an application for a permit, you must comply with District Rule 23, which requires you to (1) submit to the District, on or before the date on which such application has been set for hearing, a written Notice of Protest that complies with District Rule 23, and (2) appear at the hearing held on the application and present testimony or evidence in support of your contentions, or present a question(s) of law with regard to the application. A person who submits a written Notice of Protest who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also timely file a motion for continuance with the District demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
